SUBJECT:	Referrals for Diversion Mental Health and Substance Use Treatment Services

Under advisement from the Board of Supervisors (Board) meeting on September 10, 2019 (LF ID #96924), the Board directed that Administration provide an off-agenda report related to the total unduplicated number of people receiving diversion through mental health services (MHS), and substance use treatment services (SUTS) provided by the Behavioral Health Services Department (BHSD). This report provides the requested information.
