SUBJECT:	DataZone Information

Under advisement from the Board of Supervisors (Board) meeting on December 17, 2019 (LF ID# 99311) agenda item 25, the Board requested that Administration provide an off-agenda report on DataZone as it relates to (1) expectations of schools participating in the use of DataZone, including the (2) ability to leverage investments in mental health screening for children, and (3) to measure outcomes. This report provides the requested information.

#### Background

DataZone is currently being used by 17 Santa Clara County School Districts. DataZone has expanded its system by developing applications (apps) such as FosterVision and SLS Link. Through the SLS Link app, School Linked Services (SLS) School Districts utilizing DataZone enter service coordination information into DataZone, and School Districts provide data to Behavioral Health Services Department (BHSD) to meet service agreement requirements.

#### **Estimated Cost Analysis**

The total annual cost for all 32-school district based on the Fiscal Year 2020 student enrollment is \$1,640,942.22 and the attached DataZone Cost Analysis document includes the complete cost breakdown by school district, which includes the following: (1) initial costs of DataZone include a one-time startup cost per school district (\$10,000), DataZone Services cost (calculated by DataZone), and an Indirect cost of 9.74% with an overall total one-time startup cost of \$327,573.90 for all 32 school districts; and (2) ongoing annual cost of DataZone, which includes a cost per student (\$4.00), DataZone Services cost (calculated by DataZone), and an Indirect Cost of 9.74%.

#### Outcomes

Data is used to help monitor programs related to their goals and objectives. It provides information to conduct predictive analysis to guide program planning and insightful information to make informed decisions. Data can be used to refine and expand practices to then create sustainability plans and ensure programs are sustained for subsequent years.
