Application Process

The DocuSign applications were hosted on the County's 2021 Redistricting website from April 29 - June 1, 2021. With assistance from the Office of Communications and Public Affairs, media releases were issued on May 6 and May 25, 2021. The Redistricting Team also received support from the Board Offices, the Registrar of Voters, county commissions, voting rights organizations, community leaders, and the Silicon Valley Council of Nonprofits (SVCN) to promote the application through direct emails, newsletter articles, and social media posts. The Redistricting Team hosted two virtual informational sessions on May 26 and May 29, 2021 to provide an overview of the process and answer any questions regarding the application or selection process. As questions were asked throughout the application process, the Redistricting Team updated a Frequently Asked Questions page to the website to provide additional information.

Overview of Applicant Pool

The County received 47 applications, which all were deemed eligible for appointment. Of the 47 applications received:
