Off-Agenda Report: Expanded Categories of Eligibility for New American **Subject:**

Fellowship (NAF) Program

At the February 8, 2022, Board of Supervisors meeting (Item No. 43), the Board approved a request from Supervisor Lee to the Office of Immigrant Relations (OIR) for an off agenda report that outlines criteria for examining the need and potential impact of expanding NAF to include immigrants with additionally protected statuses.

The pilot expansion of NAF eligibility this Summer is an opportunity to collect data to inform expansion parameters including funding needs.

Below are the criteria OIR will use to evaluate future expansion potential as well as resource needs for the FY 23 New American Fellowship cycle.
