During the Board of Supervisors Meeting on August 30, 2022 (Item No. 10), Supervisor Lee requested that the Behavioral Health Services Department (BHSD) provide an off-agenda report with a status update relating to the beds contracted with Crestwood Behavioral Health, Inc. (Crestwood) and the amendments to increase the beds.

BHSD currently contracts with Crestwood for 55 beds at Crestwood's San Jose Mental Health Rehabilitation Center (MHRC). BHSD will be taking a phased approached to add a total of 45 beds by June 30, 2024. The contract with Crestwood will be amended and presented to the Board of Supervisors on November 15, 2022, for execution, which will add a total of 20 beds. Placement of the 20 beds is anticipated to be completed by January 2023. The second phase of the contract amendment to add the remaining 25 beds will be executed in July 2023 and anticipated placement within Fiscal Year 2024.

Although the amendment that will be executed by November 2022 will result in an additional 20 beds, it does not necessarily mean that 20 individuals can be placed into the 20 beds immediately after the amendment is executed. Placement is dependent on the transition and discharge of individuals from other counties in the MHRC, which affects the availability of beds. After an existing individual (from a different county) no longer requires subacute level of care and is discharged, a bed will become available for a new Santa Clara County patient. This will also apply to the placement of individuals for the remaining 25 beds in the second phase. It is important to note that a portion of the remaining 25 beds is currently occupied by individuals from rural counties and placement of a Santa Clara County patient will be contingent on the discharge or availability of the bed occupied by individuals from rural counties and placement of an alternative placement.
